The museum staff report the object, as the sales history of the piece raises questions for them.



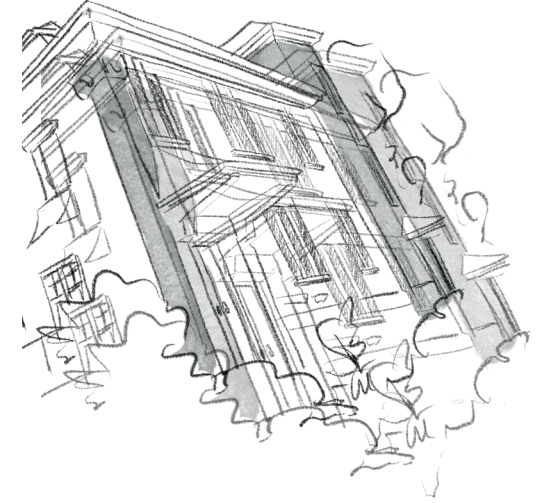
